



# THE HONG KONG UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

## FEES FOR 2011-12 ACADEMIC YEAR

(Information as of June 2011)

Except for caution money, fees described below are not refundable.

### 1. Tuition/program fees for undergraduate students

Tuition/program fees are payable in two equal installments at the beginning of each regular term.

- Local students ..... \$42,100 per annum<sup>(1)</sup>
- Non-local students<sup>(2)</sup> ..... \$100,000 per annum\*

\* The following tuition fee schedule applies to non-local undergraduate students admitted in the years specified below:

(a) from 2007-08 to 2010-11

Enrolled in the BBA Global Business program or the Dual Degree program in Technology and Management .... \$80,000 + Program Fee \$20,000 per annum<sup>^</sup>

Enrolled in other undergraduate degree programs ..... \$80,000 per annum  
(<sup>^</sup> students enrolling in the preparatory year are not required to pay the program fee)

(b) in 2006-07

Enrolled in the BBA Global Business program or the Dual Degree program in Technology and Management ..... \$90,000 per annum

Enrolled in other undergraduate degree programs ..... \$70,000 per annum

### 2. Tuition fees for research postgraduate students

Tuition fees are payable in two equal installments at the beginning of each regular term.

- Full-time ..... \$42,100 per annum
- Part-time ..... \$21,050 per annum

### 3. Tuition fees for taught postgraduate students

Taught postgraduate programs are self-financing programs. The program fees are shown in their respective program entries at the Program Catalog [http://publish.ust.hk/prog\\_crs\\_ar/pgprog](http://publish.ust.hk/prog_crs_ar/pgprog)

### 4. Tuition fees for visiting students

(a) Undergraduate visiting students

- Local ..... \$2,110 per credit
- Non-local<sup>(2)</sup> ..... \$5,000 per credit

(b) Postgraduate visiting students

Tuition is charged on a per-credit basis. Details can be obtained from the Admissions, Registration and Records Office.

- (c) Undergraduate / Postgraduate visiting internship students ..... \$1,754 per credit

- 5. Partial fees**
- (a) Undergraduate study beyond the normal period of study
    - Local ..... \$1,690 per credit<sup>(3)</sup>
    - Non-local<sup>(2)</sup> ..... \$4,000 per credit<sup>(4)</sup>
  - (b) Executive Committee member of the Students' Union approved to take a reduced credit load ..... \$1,690 per credit<sup>(3)</sup>
  - (c) Research postgraduate students with Continuing Student status ..... \$5,265 per regular term
  - (d) Research postgraduate students studying beyond the normal period
    - Full-time ..... \$21,050 per regular term<sup>(5)</sup>
    - Part-time ..... \$10,525 per regular term<sup>(5)</sup>

**6. Caution money:** Each new student is required to pay a deposit of \$300 as caution money on first registration. Charges will be made against this deposit if there are any unpaid claims against the student, such as outstanding library dues. The balance will be refunded if the student leaves the University before graduation. At graduation, the student is required to restore the balance of the caution money to its original level and the full amount of the caution money will be transferred toward the graduation fee.

**7. Graduation fee:** Upon completion of the program of study and before the degree or diploma is awarded, each student is required to pay a graduation fee of \$300. The fee is normally settled by transferring the full amount of the caution money.

**8. Students' Union fee:** Students joining the Students' Union are required to pay an initial entry fee and thereafter an annual subscription. These fees are set by the Union and collected by the University on behalf of the Union. The entry fee, applicable to students admitted for the first time, is \$100 and the annual subscription is \$100.

**9. Late Charges:** Students may be required to pay late charges for failure to complete certain University procedures by stipulated deadlines. These include overdue library books. Late charges are levied in accordance with the rules and regulations set by the respective offices.

**10. Charges per person for on-campus students accommodation**

Undergraduate Halls:	
Single rooms .....	\$18,200 - \$20,930 per residential year*
Double rooms .....	\$10,800 - \$15,550 per residential year*
Triple rooms .....	\$8,090 - \$9,300 per residential year*
Bunk-bed rooms .....	\$8,970 - \$10,320 per residential year *
Postgraduate Halls:	
Single rooms .....	\$31,839 per residential year <sup>#</sup>
University Apartments:	
Single rooms .....	\$24,789 - \$28,059 per residential year (excluding utility charges) <sup>Δ</sup>
Double rooms .....	\$15,296 per residential year* (excluding utility charges) <sup>Δ</sup>

All rooms are air-conditioned and the charges do not include electricity charges for air-condition. All charges are paid in advance by installments.

- \* The 2011-12 residential year covers the period from 30 August 2011 to 3 June 2012. The rates of charges are subject to confirmation.
- # The 2011-12 residential year covers the period from 29 August 2011 to 31 May 2012. The rates of charges are subject to confirmation.
- Δ The 2011-12 residential year covers the period from 15 August 2011 to 30 June 2012. The rates of charges are subject to confirmation.

Notes:

- (1) For local students admitted in 2004-05 onwards to the Dual Degree Program in Technology and Management, the tuition for their 4th year of study is \$60,000 per annum.
- (2) For the purpose of admission of non-local students, non-local students are defined by the University Grants Committee as persons entering Hong Kong for the purpose of education with a student visa/entry permit issued by the Director of Immigration.
- (3) Maximum amount chargeable for a regular term is \$21,050.
- (4) Maximum amount chargeable for a regular term is \$50,000.
- (5) 50% of the tuition fee paid for that regular term will be refunded if all program and residency requirements of the University have been met within the first three calendar months of a regular term.
