

24. Failure in a core or required course twice

Students must take and pass all core and required courses specified for their program of study. When a student fails a core or required course twice, the major department may recommend that the student be dismissed from the University. This requires endorsement by the Dean and approval by the Academic Progress Review Panel. An appeal against the Panel's decision should be made to the Vice-President for Academic Affairs. Alternative actions based on individual exceptional circumstances may be approved in consultation with the Office of the Vice-President for Academic Affairs.
